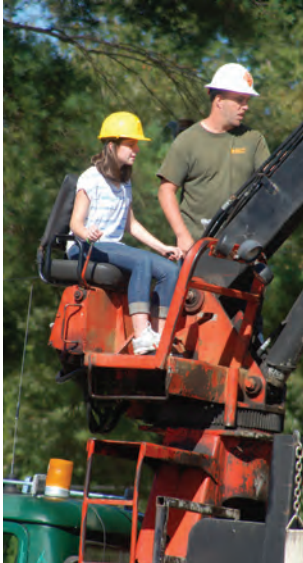

## HANDS-ON ACTIVITIES

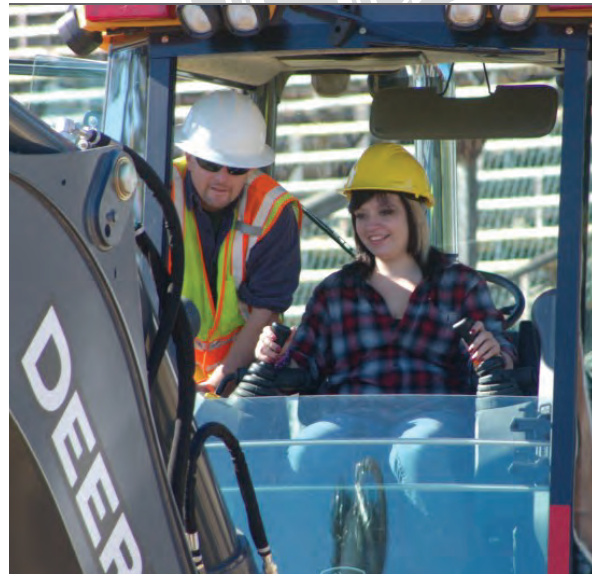
By far the most popular area for students is the first hand experience to explore construction occupations including welding, plumbing, surveying, electrical wiring, hammering, brick laying, and using drills.

Also available for the students to observe is sewer video inspection truck, personal protection equipment, storm water run-off model, PVC piping demonstration and much more.



## HEAVY EQUIPMENT DEMONSTRATIONS

Students experience first-hand heavy equipment, from general information instructions from the experts to being able to sit in the driver's seat.
